Town and Country—A story of about early 1970s suburban life revolving about a group of young boys and their encounter with a grouchy old man.

The Last Road Trip—Story of a man who encounters a friend from college having some difficulties and he decided to visit his gang of old college friends. In the end, the reader will learn that the narrator is making the trip because he had terminal cancer and the thing his cherished most was his memories with former friends.
